Overview

Advancements in Cancer Management is an educational forum designed to foster dialogue between primary care providers (PCPs) and the oncology team and to provide strategies that contribute to integrative cancer care for patients. Topics such as screening and diagnosis, managing co-morbidities and treatment-related side effects, and palliative care will be covered for PCPs to expand their knowledge and transform their practices in cancer care.
