The purpose of this is to better prepare eligible providers to identify individuals with opioid use disorders and to engage those patients in medication for their opioid use disorder.

Trainees attend this 4 hour live training taught by clinical expert, Dr. Samuel Martin. Once completed, participants will receive the second half of the course – a 4 hour online self-study portion. At the end of the course, participants are required to pass an exam with a 75% or higher before applying for their waiver.
